## SUMMARY

In response to requests from DuPont Teijin Films, Mitsubishi Polyester Film, Inc., and SKC, Inc. (collectively, Petitioners), the Department of Commerce (the Department) initiated an administrative review of the antidumping duty order on polyethylene terephthalate film, sheet and strip (PET film) from Brazil.<sup>1</sup> On February 6, 2015, the Department published, in the Federal Register, a notice of revocation of the antidumping duty order on PET film from Brazil, effective November 10, 2013.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, this administrative review covers Terphane Ltda. and Terphane Inc. (collectively, Terphane) for the period of review (POR) November 1, 2013, through November 9, 2013. As we currently have no evidence of any reviewable entries, shipments or sales of subject PET film by Terphane during the POR, we are issuing a preliminary no shipment determination.

## BACKGROUND

We conducted a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) entry query for entries of subject merchandise under A-351-841 during the period November 1, 2013 through October 31, 2014. We received the results of this query on February 2, 2015.<sup>3</sup> Terphane submitted a claim of no shipments on February 5, 2013.<sup>4</sup>
