Producers/exporters of sugar from Mexico requesting to accede to the Agreement Suspending the Antidumping Duty Investigation on Sugar from Mexico (original Agreement), as amended (amended Agreement),<sup>1</sup> must submit this form, with two witness signatures, to the U.S. Department of Commerce (the Department). A signatory to the original Agreement that is not also a signatory to the *Amendment* must separately indicate its accession to the amended Agreement by means of submission of this form to the Department in order to continue as a signatory to the amended Agreement, and must include in the Signatory ID field the number it was assigned when it acceded to the original Agreement. Upon receiving a request for accession, the Department will confirm in writing the producer's/exporter's accession to the amended Agreement and its signatory number or issue a new signatory number to the producer/exporter, as applicable.

Signatory ID Numbers are valid only for the producer/exporter name in the corresponding accession request. The producer/exporter name on this form must be identical to the producer/exporter name on the entry documentation presented to U.S. Customs and Border Protection. In the event that the name of the producer/exporter changes, it must withdraw from the amended Agreement with respect to the old company name, and submit an accession form for the new company name.
