NOTIFICATIONS OF LAWS, REGULATIONS AND
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES RELATING
TO SAFEGUARD MEASURES

ARGENTINA

The following communication, dated 30 March 1995, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Argentina.

With reference to Article 12.6 of the WTO Agreement on Safeguards and the Decision of the Committee on Safeguards, I have the pleasure of notifying the Committee on Safeguards that the Marrakesh Agreement Establishing the World Trade Organization and its annexed Agreements, contained in the Final Act, have been totally incorporated into Argentinian legislation by means of Law No. 24,425. It should be noted that there are not, as of yet, other laws, decrees or regulations relating to safeguard measures, with the exception of the provisions contained in the text of the Decision respecting the WTO, which constitutes the national legislation in this respect.
